- ♦ **Stall Fees:** \$25 per stall per day / \$35 per stall overnight
- ♦ **Trailer Tie Fee:** \$5 per horse per day
- ♦ **Overnight camping:** \$35 for overnight, \$15 if you plug in for the day. Pay with entry fees.

Negative EIA Test within last 12 months required for all horses. Please provide **2 copies** to entry booth.
ALL OUT-OF-STATE HORSES MUST PROVIDE A VALID HEALTH CERTIFICATE.

Entry Booth Information:

1. Horse's official name and registration number where required as well as current owner of record. A photo copy of both sides of registration papers must be presented when entries are made.
2. Exhibitor's name.
3. WHOA professional number, WHOA membership number, WHOA youth number, Trainer's number or temporary day card.

Note: All of the above must be on the class entry sheet before the DQP will inspect the entry.

- ♦ See 2017 WHOA rulebook for Division and Class Rules, Class Definitions and Requirements.
- ♦ Classes are open to adult and youth participants unless otherwise specified.
- ♦ **Speed Events:** Safety helmets required for all youth 17 & under, optional for adults.
- ♦ **O/T:** Denotes optional tack & attire (English or Western) but not a combination thereof.
- ♦ **Amateur Own/Train:** No professional training within 90 days.
- ♦ **Novice Horse:** Has not won 3 blues in a mounted rail class since 01-01-14 (excludes equitation classes)
- ♦ **Novice Rider:** Has not won 3 blues in a mounted rail class since 01-01-14 (includes equitation classes)
- ♦ **Groom's Class:** Rider not to compete in any other classes at this show. WHOA/Trainer card not required, casual or work attire.
- ♦ **ALL:** Open to all divisions offered @ this show.
- ♦ These shows follow the regulations set forth by the WHOA HIO and the TWHBEA Versatility Program.
- ♦ Persons on federal disqualification cannot transport horses to these shows and can only participate as a spectator.
- ♦ All classes subject to show management approval.
- ♦ Affiliated with the WHOA HIO.
