Definitions and Explanations for various classes

Pleasure Day

Novice Horse: The horse has never won a blue ribbon in that specific class.

Novice Person/Rider: The handler has never won a blue ribbon in that specific class.

Leadless Showmanship: A showmanship pattern must be executed without the use of a lead attached to the horse.

Stick Horse Race: No fee for this class. It may be split into age and/or gender groups. A local club will help in the morning to make the stick horses for each participant. All materials will be supplied

Costume Class: Entries will self-declare into one of the three groups listed. Each group will be placed 1-6.

Open English Walk/Trot: Will be judged on 50% pleasure skills and 50% equitation skills.

Parent & Child Walk/Trot: one horse, two riders. Parent will ride first, dismount in center, child will mount and ride. Will be judged as a team. No tack change allowed except for stirrup length.

Open Western Walk/Trot: Will be judged on 50% pleasure skills and 50% horsemanship skills.

Speed & Fun Games Day

Pleasure type horse: A horse who normally competes in open and breed-type events.

Speed type horse: A horse who normally competes in speed & gymkhana events.

Please—no cross entering between pleasure and speed types

Gamblers Choice for Cross Rails & Green Hunter: Rider is able to choose their own pattern for the jumps but all jumps must be completed.

Simon Sez: While mounted on the horse, must follow directions from the judge only when “simon sez” is stated.

Ribbon Race: A team of 2 horse/riders will hold a piece of crepe paper between themselves and proceed down the arena and around the barrel and back. Fastest time, without a broken/lost crepe paper is the winner.

Catalog Race: Horse/rider proceeds down the arena to a barrel and pulls a specific page number from the catalog on the top of the barrel and gets back to the finish line. Fastest time, with the correct page intact, wins.

Champagne Race: A team of 4 horse/riders must relay a glass of “champagne” to another team member on the other side of the arena and pour their “champagne” into the next riders glass and so on until all team members have participated. The team with the most liquid left in their glass is the winner.

Costume Class: Entries will self-declare into one of the three groups listed. Each group will be placed 1-6.

Speed & Action: Horse/rider must stay within the starting box for 5 seconds and then race down and around the barrel and back into the starting box, staying within the box for an additional 5 seconds. Stepping out of the box disqualifies the rider. Winner is the fastest time.

Key Hole Race: Horse/rider must proceed down the arena and enter a “key hole” slot at the end of the arena and then turn their horse around within the circle at the end of the slot and race back to the start/finish line. Stepping out of the slot or circle disqualifies the rider. Winner is the fastest time.

Tandem Bareback: 2 riders riding bareback on one horse, at a walk and/or trot. Riders will be asked to switch places during the class.

Bribe A Horse: Horse does not have a lead on and needs to follow the handler around the barrel at the end of the arena and back to the start line. Horse may not cross the start/finish line before the handler or they will be disqualified. Winner is the fastest time.
