



Barrel Racing & Pole Bending Series - Arena Rules

- - No dogs in the barns or arenas during events - All dogs must be on a leash.
- No smoking in any barns or arenas
- No strollers or children in the holding.
- 1 horse per stall - no sharing a stall—Stalls are limited if you reserve you are responsible for payment - you must fill out a stall reservation form for each event or for the series. Must cancel 5:00 pm Thursday before event.
- Online entries close 5:00 pm Friday night prior to event - you are responsible for any entries made online and payment is due if you do not draw out prior to 5:00 pm Friday.
- All riders must check in with gateman - 7 horses are allowed in holding pen
- If you have a safety issues with your horse please talk with Arena Manager and gate man prior to making your run. Safety of you and your and others is our main concern. You may be asked to dismount and lead your horse into the arena if your horse is posing a danger to you or others in the holding pen. You will be given 2 minutes to get your horse in the arena and start your run. If it is deemed that your horse is acting in a manner that is unsafe to you or others you could be Disqualified.
- No excessive whipping, jerking or tuning on your horse in or out of the competition arena, this could be cause for DQ and you will be asked to leave the competition.
- Warm Up Sessions - if you reserve a session you will have to pay for that session whether you ride in it or not, only 1 horse per session, no sharing a session, no ponying a horse.
- There will be no schooling of horse on the pattern during a class. Riders may be fined \$20 for circling the barrel more than once. We want the ground to be as fair as possible for each rider.
- No refunds of entries after draw is posted, all office fees are not refundable.
- The 3 call rule will be used and enforced. If you are not at the gate after your name has been called 3 times you will be disqualified .
- Running out of posted draw with result in a no time
- Contestants knocking over a barrel or pole will receive a no time
- W9 form for current year must be on file in office in order to receive winnings. Checks will be written to contestant only including youth.
- \$25.00 returned check fee plus bank charge on all NFS checks and rider then is on a cash only payment.
- We do not accept credit or debit cards.
- All checks not pickup at the end of the show will be held until you come again, unless you fill out a self addressed envelope at the office and leave \$1.00 in it and we will mail those out Monday after the event.
