Definitions and Explanations for various classes

Pleasure Day

Novice Exhibitor: The exhibitor has never won a blue ribbon in that class.

Leadless Showmanship: A showmanship pattern must be executed without the use of a lead attached to the horse.

Parent & Child Walk/Trot: One horse, two riders. Parent will ride first, dismount in center, child will mount and ride. Will be judged as a team. No tack change allowed except for stirrup length. Both riders must be declared on the entry form.

Ranch, Speed & Fun Day

Pleasure type horse: A horse who normally competes in open and breed-type events.

Speed type horse: A horse who normally competes in speed & gymkhana events.

No cross entering between pleasure and speed types

Tandem Bareback: 2 riders riding bareback on one horse, at a walk or trot. Riders will be asked to switch places during the class. Both riders must be declared on the entry form.

Bareback Equitation Pattern: A pattern must be ridden bareback on the horse. It does not matter if it is ridden Western or English.

Ribbon Race: A team of 2 horse/riders will hold a piece of crepe paper between themselves and proceed down the arena and around the barrel and back. Fastest time, without a broken/lost crepe paper piece is the winner.

Catalog Race: Horse/rider proceeds down the arena to a barrel and pulls a specific page number from a catalog placed on the top of the barrel and gets back to the finish line. Fastest time, with the correct page intact, wins.

Costume Class: Exhibitors enter one of the categories listed. Each category will be placed 1-6.

Chuck A Duck: No horses needed. Everyone can participate! Participants receive 2 ducks to toss into a ring placed in the arena. Closest duck to the ring is the winner. If the class is large enough we will split between youth and adults. Additional ducks may be purchased for 50¢ each while supplies last.

Leadline Barrel Race, Leadline Flag Race & Leadline Egg & Spoon: These classes can be shown either with a young horse (2 years and under) lead by the exhibitor through the pattern or an older horse (3 years and over) ridden by any age exhibitor and led through the pattern. Winner is the fastest qualified time.

Speed & Action: Horse/rider must stay within the starting box for 5 seconds and then race down and around the barrel and back into the starting box, staying within the box for an additional 5 seconds. Stepping out of the box disqualifies the rider. Winner is the fastest qualified time.

Bribe A Horse: Horse does not have a lead on and needs to follow the handler around the barrel at the end of the arena and back to the start line. Horse may not cross the start/finish line before the handler or they will be disqualified. Winner is the fastest qualified time.
